CULTURAL DAY TRIPS - COASTAL RESERVE - MOUNTAINOUS NATIONAL PARK - UNESCO HERITAGE



PESARO & URBINO - RIVIERA DELLE COLLINE (HILLS)

Ranging from the Apennine Foothills to the Adriatic Sea, Urbino and Pesaro are characterised by hills and highlands, mild weather all year round, and a variety of experiences.



Pesaro - Piazza del Popolo and the Palazzo Ducale and moving to the Civic Museums including the famous Ceramics Museum. As the birthplace of composer Gioacchino Rossini, visit the house-museum or join the annual Rossini Opera Festival, drawing enthusiasts from around the world.

Gradara - experience a truly Medieval village complete with its original defensive walls and square castle.

Fano - town with a wealth of historical landmarks, such as the Arch of Augustus and the Palazzo Malatesta, home to the Civic Museum and Painting Gallery, with collections ranging from the Neolithic period to the present. The yearly The Carnevale di Fano in February, boasts ancient roots, with its floats parading amidst music, lights and colors, and the handing out of candies and chocolates.

Urbino - Listed as a UNESCO World heritage Site, this walled Medieval cities is one of the most important Renaissance sites in Italy. Make sure you see the incredible Ducal Palace built in XV and the Galleria delle Marche that hosts some of the most famous Renaissance art pieces in Italy.

Beaches - The remote beaches at foot of the Nature Reserve, San Bartolo and Ardizio are great for families if you want a small pit-stop

Furlo pass - The Furlo Pass (Italian: Gola del Furlo or Passo del Furlo) is a gorge on the ancient Roman road Via Flaminia in the Marche region of central Italy, where many historic figures such as Emperor Honorius passed through.

Cuisine - Years of history and traditions have influenced the local cuisine, many of which have remained unchanged. Don't leave Pesaro without trying out the tournedos alla Rossini, a braised fillet with ham, mushrooms, parsley, lemon and pepper.

San Marino - Although not part of this province, it is next door. San Marino is a mountainous microstate surrounded by north-central Italy. Among the world's oldest republics, it retains much of its historic architecture and sits high above the land, overlooking kilometres of countryside.

ANCONA - CAPITAL OF LE MARCHE

Founded by the Greeks, Ancona, meaning 'elbow' lies on the foothills of Monte Conero. Think evergreen woods, white high cliffs, and pristine beaches and delicious cuisine!



Ancona - The city is composed of two districts: the old town, perched on the Guasco Hill, and the modern city. Start at San Ciriaco Cathedral and head towards Trajan's Triumphal Arch and the remains of the Roman Amphitheatre. The Mole Vanvitelliana is a prime touristic draw, along with the nearby Church of Sant'Agostino. Between museums, palaces, and days at the beach, other highlights include Castelfidardo, Offagna, and Recanati, the birthplace of Giacomo Leopardi. This area (like our Estate) also the only place on the Adriatic coast that benefits from sunrises and sunsets!

Riviera del Conero - The protected Conero area borders Le Marche's coastline covers nearly 200 km and offers one of the highest number of Blue Flag beaches on mainland Italy. The clear coast is dotted with coves accessible only by sea that alternate with equipped beaches, historic villages, and lots of culture.

Best beaches - Due Sorelle beach at Sirolo with its clear blue waters only accessible by boat (see our Aperitivo and sailing trip!) Portonovo, Mezzavalle and San Michele, for the scenery and natural formations, and Vela Beach. There is also the sandy shore of Grotta Urbani and Sassi Neri Beach

Hilltop & beach towns - In Numana & Sirolo, a medieval village are great for a stroll. Close to the border with the Region of Umbria and tucked into the mountains is Fabriano, renowned for its art and paper artisanship since the 13th Century.

Adventure sports - Outdoor activities are vast and situated in beautiful scenery, particularly trekking, road and mountain bike cycling, rock-climbing, watersports (summer) and horseback riding, while lovers of winter sports can enjoy Nordic and alpine skiing in the winter months. Between Senigallia and Ancona provides many an opportunity for diving, sailing, fishing and parachuting - Portonovo has many to offer.

Frasassi Caves - Not to be missed are the three Frasassi Caves, the largest underground cave network in Europe, discovered only in 1971 by a 21 year old climber. The Grotte di Frasassi, a wonderland of calcareous stalagmites and stalactites date as far back as 150 million years ago.

Loreto - The Lourdes of Italy, the home of Italy's largest shrine to the Virgin Mary and a place where people go to get blessed if they are suffering. A dramatic square hosts the church, surrounded by plenty restaurants and bars. Legend says the shrine was brought over from Jerusalem by the angels.

Cuisine - Excellent olive oil, honey, wild mussels (Moscioli), fish stew brodetto all'anconetana and great wines such as Verdicchio, Rosso Conero, Lacrima di Morro d'Alba.

MACERTA - OUR PROVINCE

Macerata is composed of a natural scenery mountains, hills, valleys, woods and cultivated fields running all the way to the shores of the Adriatic.



Macerata - It only takes a walk along Corso Matteotti - Macerata's main thoroughfare, near Piazza della Libertà, with the Palazzo dei Priori and its statues and plaques - to discover Macerata's 16th-Century architecture. Here stand the Renaissance-style Prefecture's Palace, St. Paul's Church and the Teatro Rossi, built in the 18th Century. **Opera & Theatre** - with its countless theatres and amazing productions, will not disappoint those keen on drama and opera. The theatrical season reaches its peak with the A. Perugini National Dramatic Art Review and the celebrated opera season held at the Sferisterio. Equally well-known is the Macerata Jazz Festival.

Abbey of Chiaravalle di Fiastra & Urbisaglia - The medieval town is a pretty brick-built hamlet with a friendly atmosphere and characteristic streets to wander, decked with carefully-kept old buildings, some palazzi and churches. The Abbazia della Fiastra was established as a monastery by Cistercian monk in 1142. Enjoy the wine and farming museum as well as some great barbeques to savour before you return home.

Adventure or relax - trails for trekking, horseback riding, paragliding as well as mountain biking are infinite through the Sibillini Mountains. Even off-slope skiing in the Azzurri Mountains is possible. For those simply looking to relax, the area offers thermal spas in Sarnano and Tolentino.

Sibillini mountains, Lago Di Fiastra & Lame Rosse In summer visit the National Park, Lame rosse's distinctive red rocky shapes, and swim in the Fiastra lake, have a typical mountain lunch followed by horse riding or head a bit west for the magical **Castelluccio del Norcio flowering** season May - July. In winter this is the perfect area for skiing.

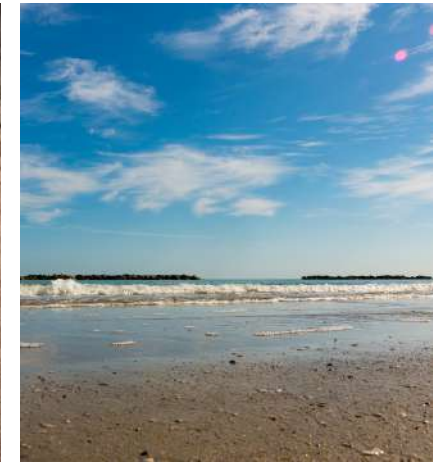
Sarnano - A charming town named as "one of the prettiest towns in Italy" and also awarded the prestigious "Orange Flag" from the Italian Touring Club. Surrounded by hills and woods on a hill, it is located at the foot of the Sibillini Mountains. Despite its small size, the town has everything for daily life, and more...with well-preserved buildings in the town centre dating back as far as 1265. There are many lovely churches here, and the locals pride themselves on their excellent local cuisine, along with soothing hot springs! **Cingoli** - The ancient village of Recanati deserves mention as the birthplace of Giacomo Leopardi the famous Italian philosopher and of 20th-Century tenor Beniamino Gigli.

Coastal towns - Potenza Picena is the location for the Villa Giardino Buonaccorsi, the only example of an 18th-Century Italian garden still in perfect condition. After, Civitanova Marche and Porto Recanati are worth a visit for those who love the sea.

Cuisine - A typical tasty dishes include, brodetto of Porto Recanati, a fish soup (cuttlefish and saffron), vincisgrassi, (lasagne and meat sauce), ciausculu is a lean, salame, finely minced and seasoned with garlic, parmigiana di gobbi (thistle). Desserts include biscotti col mosto and the area's crescia fagliata. Among the D.O.C. wines are the Bianco dei Colli Maceratesi, the celebrated Verdicchio di Matelica, the Vernaccia di Serrapetrona and spumante.

FERMO-LAND OF TRADITIONS & VILLAGES

Stretching from coast to Sibilini mountains, with rolling hills and historic villages filled with history, art and culinary traditions.



Fermo - an ancient Roman colony and a vast museum in itself, and today the Provincial capital of a larger and varied production zone. Fret not over Fermo's more modern aspects, for the Roman baths, the Duomo, the Renaissance-style piazza, and the Teatro dell'Aquila all await to tell of its long and noble history.

Beachtowns - Lined with golden beaches and shady pine trees you'll find the modern beach and tiny fisherman's houses in **Porto Sant'Elpidio**, the Lido in Fermo, the intact fishing village of **Porto San Giorgio**, the gravel strips of Marina Palmense and Marina di Altidona, and the coves of **Pedaso** offer a perfect combination of natural landscapes and high-quality services, from the touristic port to the long cycling trails, and from the lively chalets to the picturesque trattorias. For the view, go high on the headland, to **Torre di Palme**, a fortified village, then built up around the churches and convents, today it is a splendid vantage point from which to view the sea.

Sibillini Mountain villages - The small village of Montefortino is placed in a sloping position on the right of the Tenna river, embraced by the Sibillini Mountains. There are several places of interest to visit such as the Gole dell'Infernaccio, natural gorges formed by the River Tenna, with a truly unique landscape and panorama, where at the end of the adventurous walk you will be enchanted by the hidden waterfall and the hermitage of San Leonardo al Volubrio, a destination for continuous pilgrimages and excursions.

Beautiful hamlets - Moresco and Monterubbiano number among the most beautiful hamlets in Italy, while Campofilone solemnly faces the valley with its abbey complex and gates, and Monte Vidon Combatte boasts views that stretch all the way to Gran Sasso. **Montefalcone Appennino** - is an old picturesque medieval village perched on a rocky spur some 750 meters up high, facing the Sibillini Mountains - which author Guido Piovene described as "the most legendary mountains in Central Italy". The historic centre is mainly medieval, built from local stone and perched on high ridge 757 m a.s The village has two churches dating from the 14th century and offers stunningly beautiful vistas onto the Sibillini mountains. **Amandola** - The town was founded in 1248 and is named after the almond trees which grow here. It sits on a hill 550m above sea level with stunning views. This town also has an interesting wartime history when the local people risked their lives to protect a small Jewish group fleeing the Nazis. **Montefortino** is also a hilltop medieval town with stupendous views of the Sibilline mountain peaks. It was originally a Roman outpost, but the medieval walls were constructed in the 13th century. Its streets built in semi-circles around a medieval centre. There are several beautiful old churches, and there is also an art gallery in the magnificent 16th century Palazzo Leopardi.

Cuisine - The pecorino grape, (pecore is sheep in Italian) who used to graze on it, is thought to have originated in the Sibillini mountains of Fermo, even though it is now grown in other provinces of Le Marche. Cereals, olives and mustard are grown and produced and the fish and seafood along the coast, in particular Porto San Giorgio, of this province are excellent. Maccheroncini di Campofilone is a variety of pasta that has received the PGI and is made exclusively in the town of Campofilone. Only fresh eggs are allowed to be used and no other liquid can be added.

ASCOLI PICENO - LAND OF THE OLIVES

Ascoli Piceno is the southernmost Province in The Marches.



Ascoli Piceno - is a town of art, culture, theatre productions and strong traditions with its must-see Piazza del Popolo. Many of Ascoli's museums are concentrated in Piazza Arringo, also known as 'Museum Square;' they include the Pinacoteca Civica (the public art gallery), with its many masterpieces by Titian, Guido Reni and Giuseppe Pellizza da Volped; the Diocesan Museum and the State Archeological Museum.

Sibillini National Park - close by you can visit the Gran Sasso-Laga National Park and the Sibilla Peak. Not far from the town lies Mt. Ascensione, a destination for pilgrimages during the Middle Ages that, nowadays, retains its sacred atmosphere. Indeed, every year in May, thousands of people ascend the mountain on Ascension Day to carry the Madonna da Polesio to the church at its top.

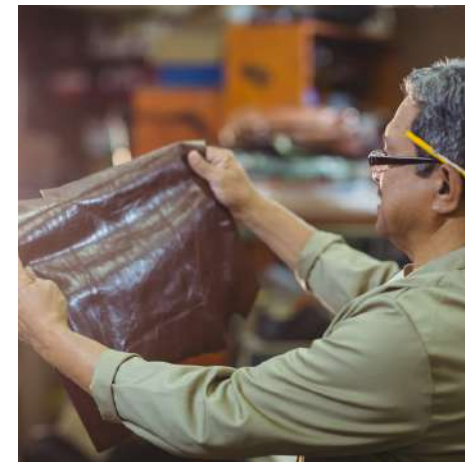
Sibilini Activities - trek and hike along the wooded trails and slopes of the Sibilline Mountains, perhaps en route to the Sibilla Cave. Nesting nearby is Lake Pilato where, according to legend, Pontius Pilate was dragged beneath its surface by buffaloes. Bicycle holidays combine the beauty of nature with the pursuit of sport, in discovery of the territory and traditional cuisine along the way. Many routes, both on- and off-road, have been designed to explore this varied environment, ranging from mountains to sea, and featuring climbs and descents, woods and rocky areas - all amidst breathtaking views. Acquasanta Terme is the ideal location for restoring both body and soul at a thermal spa used by the Romans, now with all the modern comforts.

Close by towns - one encounters towns such as **Offida**, with its 15th-Century fortress. Glimpses of the Middle Ages can be found in **Ripatransone**, also known as the belvedere del Piceno for its panoramic location. Among the coastal towns, worthy of note are the narrow streets of **Grottammare**, and the sandy beach at **San Benedetto del Tronto**, not to mention the incredible restaurants in these locations.

Cuisine - The fresh egg pastas are among the leading dishes, from simple tagliatelle to Campofilone maccheroncini and chitarrine. The traditional eve of holiday menus includes spaghetti in tuna sauce, green olives and tomatoes. Alternatively, mountain soups are made with lentils or legumes sourced from the nearby mountains. The traditional fritto misto all'ascolana is a must, featuring the renowned local olives, stuffed with meat, liver and tomatoes and then deep-fried. The fritto can also include cream, zucchini, artichoke and lamb cutlets. Olives are also used in the turkey all'ascolana, seasoned with aromatic herbs, juniper berries and liver. Piceno wines have gained a reputation throughout Italy for their quality. The most popular are Rosso Piceno, Rosso Piceno Superiore and the Bianco Falerio dei Colli Ascolani.

THE LAND OF LEATHER - LUXURY SHOPPING

The leather region of Italy



Le Marche is famous worldwide for its superlative manufacturing of luxury leather goods, especially, shoes, bags and hats. Family run business are also dotted around the region offering the opportunity to purchase quality leather goods or even have bespoke items tailormade. Producing 90% of all Italian shoes, look out for traditional shoe-maker for a tailormade treat.

Head to Montegranaro near Fermo which has been a shoemaking mecca since the 18th century. Here you will find boutiques and outlets for high-end brands including Dino Bigioni, and Zeis Excelsa shoes. The tiny village of Torre San is home to designer Rocco Pistolessi, famous for the brand's characteristic snake skin and crocodile leather.

If you are on a mission to find some investment pieces or luxury gifts head to Monte San Pietangeli which has stores including Nero Giardini, also check out Filottrano which tailors suits for the likes of Genny, Lardini, Tamantini and Sartoria Luca Paolorossi. Finally, stop of at Civitanova for some serious heels by Cesare Paciotti, Santoni or Strategia and don't' forget to pass by Sant 'Elpidio a Mare to visit the headquarters and outlet store of the world-famous brand Tod's factory and outlets only 20 minutes drive from Villa Olivo.

OUR WINE

LE MARCHE

Le Marche's wine making heritage spans thousands of years, whilst our typography allows us to produce varied and some of the best wines in Italy, with the region's wines starting to make their mark on the international wine-scene.

Well-known wine towns include the capital, Ancona, and lovely Ascoli Piceno, Cupramontana, Matelica, Cingoli, Fabriano, Conero, the beautiful fortified village of Jesi, Recanati (also famous for being the birthplace of one of Italy's most famous poets- Giacomo Leopardi), Numana and lets not forget Serrapetrona where they make the only Black Vernaccia in the land!

OUR WHITES

*Well known for our whites world wide, and perfectly complementing our Adriatic freshly caught fish, Le Marche's pride is **Verdicchio** made from the local grape with the same name.*

The two DOC (Italian equivalent of French Appellation Contrôlée) for example, Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi and Verdicchio di Matelica; with their Riserva versions receiving the elite DOCG category.

Other well known Marche DOC whites include Bianchetto del Metauro and Colli Pesaresi Bianco from the north, Esino Bianco and Colli Maceratesi from the central Marche, and Falerio, and Offida Pecorino and Passerina from the south.

OUR REDS

*Unknown to many, Le Marche produces some outstanding reds. Close to the Conero peninsula, **Rosso Conero**, made from the Montepulciano grape, is a rich and perfumed with its riserva now achieving the DOCG description.*

*Alternatively, try **Rosso Piceno**, and the even better **Rosso Piceno Superiore** from the south, blend Montepulciano and Sangiovese grapes.*

***Vernaccia di Serrapetrona is the only black vernaccia in the land, a red sparkling wine** served as a sweet dessert wine with also a drier secco version; this is Le Marche's other DOCG red wine. MyoFascial Body Massage

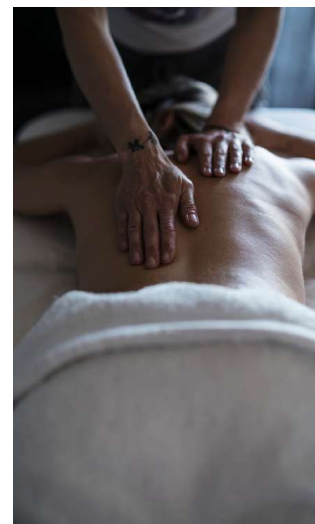

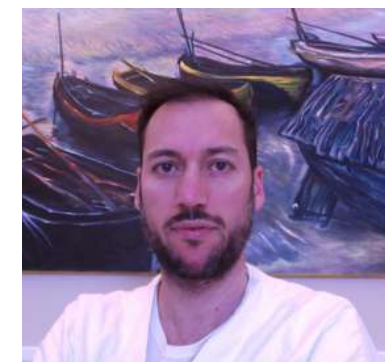
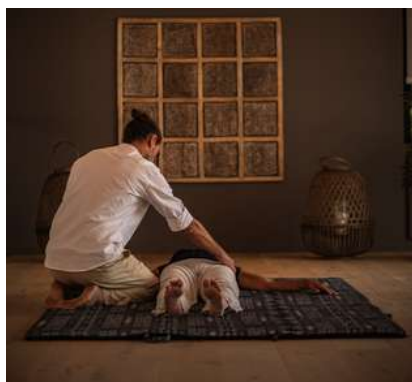
